Missouri Supreme Court Applies Strict Scrutiny to Gun Case, Upholds Ban on Felon-in-Possession

On August 5, 2014, residents of the Show Me State approved Amendment 5 that strengthened Missouri's constitutional right to keep and bear arms, with 61% voting in favor of the measure. The amendment made clear that Missouri citizens have an "unalienable" right to keep and bear arms and that any "restriction on these rights shall be subject to strict scrutiny." It also states, however, that "Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent the general assembly from enacting general laws which limit the rights of convicted violent felons or those duly adjudged mentally infirm by a court of competent jurisdiction."

As is typical with any pro-gun measure, and despite the provision's clear language concerning felons and those judicially deemed mentally infirm, opponents were quick with dire predictions of the chaos the provision would supposedly unleash. "Amendment 5 is a disaster," said a St. Louis attorney. "I mean, that was just an inexplicably bad thing that happened in the state." A Jackson County prosecutor said the amendment could have "potentially

deadly consequences" and might allow "some of the most dangerous individuals, including convicted drug dealers and gang members, to legally carry firearms." Everytown for Gun Safety, Michael Bloomberg's gun control umbrella group, blustered: "These amendments call all state and local public safety laws into question, threatening even the most basic laws designed to keep guns out of the hands of felons and domestic abusers."

As is also typical of antigun rhetoric, these statements were wrong. The Missouri Supreme Court issued an opinion in the case of Missouri v. Merritt upholding the state's felonin-possession law against a challenge brought under the state's constitutional right to keep and bear arms. "The felon-in-possession law, which bans felons from possessing firearms, with no exceptions other than possessing an antique firearm, is sufficiently narrowly tailored to achieve the compelling interest of protecting the public from firearm-related crime," the court wrote. "Therefore, it passes strict scrutiny."

Minnesota Drops Texas and Missouri from Reciprocity List

Due to recently passed firearms-reform laws, on August 1, 2015, Minnesota no longer recognizes Texas or Missouri concealed-carry licenses. This means Texas and Missouri license holders may no longer legally carry concealed or open in the State of Minnesota using their state-issued carry license.

According to the Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension's Permit to Carry Reciprocity webpage, "Missouri passed a law in 2014 to allow 19-year-old

military personnel and veterans to obtain a permit." Also, "Texas passed a law in 2014 to allow 19-year-old military personnel and veterans to obtain a permit." In both cases, the BCA says, "Minnesota law does not allow issuing permits to anyone under 21."

Two other states, Wyoming and Utah, were also removed from Minnesota's 2014 list.

Oppose Obama's Proposal to Make Information-Sharing on Guns Illegal

Several weeks ago, the State Department's proposed arms control regulations -- a rewrite which has been widely cited as an attempt to control gun-related speech on the Internet. There is a real reason to be concerned about the implications of these regulations for gun-related Internet speech.

Bottom line: These proposed regulations would define an arms "export" -- which would require State Department permission and substantial fee -- to potentially include any gun-related communication on the Internet or social media.

With this final keystone in place, the Obama administration would have the regulatory framework to comprehensively

regulate gun-related speech in cyberspace, to whatever extent it desires.

And those who violate this restriction on Internet "speech" are in danger of facing decades in prison (up to 20 years) and massive fines (up to \$1 million).

It is imperative that Americans rise up in opposition to it.

If the President persists and does not withdraw these regulations -- despite the outpouring of opposition from gun owners around the nation -- then we'll need to work through the Congress to repeal/defund them on the annual funding bill.

Gabby Giffords, Mark Kelly: We're for 'Gun Responsibility' Not 'Gun Control'

Kelly and Gabby Giffords claimed they "actually do not support 'gun control' in the traditional sense of the phrase," but "gun responsibility."

This comes after they have spent nearly three years supporting new gun trafficking laws, new laws on gun show sales, new laws on internet sales, limits on ammunition magazine capacity, expanded background checks, and gun control ubiquitously under the guise of domestic violence prevention.

Yet they say they are not for gun control.

They supported expanded background checks when Sen. Joe Manchin (D-WV) pushed them in 2013, in Washington state during the 2014 midterm elections, and, more recently, they sided with Sandy Hook Promise on SB 941 in Oregon.

Although SB 941 makes background checks universal and sets the stage for the state to confiscate privately-owned guns more easily, Kelly and Giffords say they are not for gun control.

On March 4 Giffords stood with Representative Rep. Mike Thompson (D-CA-5th) to demand that every would-be gun owner pass the same background check her attacker passed, yet she and her husband claim they are not for gun control "in the traditional sense."

According to the Essex News Daily, Kelly said, "Nobody likes to be controlled." He went on to say that the gun control group he and Giffords launched simply supports "basic principles" to keep communities safer.




