Tell Your Lawmakers TODAY: Punishing Law-Abiding Gun Owners is Not the Answer

Even as the nation was grieving the terrible loss of life in Parkland, Fla., gun control activists were doing what they do best: exploiting tragedy to advance their political agenda. Gun control activists are pushing a message that you are to blame for the criminal violence that took place last week. They're attempting to capitalize on this tragedy to convince members of Congress and State Legislatures to vote for their gun control wish list. Proposals to ban the most popular rifles in America, arbitrarily limit magazine capacity, require a waiting period on all firearm sales, and restrict the right of law-abiding young adults to acquire rifles and shotguns have been suggested as "solutions" by those who wish to curtail the rights of lawabiding gun owners. Legislation encompassing these proposals could be voted on in the U.S. Congress in the coming weeks.

That's why it's imperative that you contact your U.S. Senators and Congressional Representative today and ask them to oppose all gun control schemes that would only impact law-abiding gun owners.

Moms' group marches to Missouri capital for sensible gun laws

February 20, 2018, by Roche Madden - Jefferson City, Mo. -Hundreds of moms marched to Missouri's capital Tuesday to demand lawmakers pass sensible gun laws. Organizers admitted they have not been very successful with legislation since they were founded five years ago, but they believe the tide has turned in their favor.

"Our organization supports the Second Amendment, but we do feel with rights comes responsibilities," said Becky Morgan, Moms Demand Action.

Three years ago, 70 mothers showed up. But on Tuesday, well over 400 filled a Jefferson City hotel meeting room. The mass shooting in Parkland, Florida was on their minds.

"There is increased outrage increase passion and people just want to come here and talk to their lawmakers face-to-face because they've had it," Morgan said.

From the hotel, the group walked in the wind-whipped rain to the Missouri Capitol Building, where they pleaded with lawmakers to defeat House Bill 1936, which would force state universities to allow students to have guns and also permit guns at daycares and bars.

"I think we can all agree that guns and alcohol don't mix so it's not a smart move," said Kim Westerman of Moms Demand Action.

State Representative Jered Taylor (R-Nixa), who sponsored the bill, said he believes if people are armed they can protect themselves and others, but gun free zones only allow the criminal to carry out the crime.

"(Criminals) know they're not going to be stopped in a significant way and they're able to carry out their attack," he said.

Meanwhile, the Moms Demand Action group has a planned meeting next week in Webster Groves, but they've had such a response that they're searching for a larger venue.

Republican Chairman of the Judiciary Committee Wants to Work with Democrats on Gun Control

After the Feb. 14, 2018, school shooting in Florida, Democrats and Republicans have agreed to come together and discuss "what sort of agreement we can reach on legislation," Sen. Chuck Grassley (R-Iowa) reportedly said during a Senate Judiciary Committee meeting.

According to CBS News, Sen. Grassley is planning to sit down with Sens. Dianne Feinstein (D-California) and John Cornyn (R-Texas) to talk about possible gun control legislation. "Today, grief and sorrow on our part is really not adequate because, for the past 25 years, I have seen this committee do exactly that and do nothing," Feinstein said. "This isn't going to stop, members. This is going to continue. And we become culpable when we do nothing to stop it."

On top of adding more gun control, legislators also claim they will take a look at the glaring mental health issue in America.

NRA backlash: These are the companies cutting ties

Several companies are ending their ties to the National Rifle Association in the wake of last week's massacre at a Florida high school that left 17 dead. Four major companies, Enterprise Holdings, First National Bank of Omaha, Symantec, and MetLife are among the first to call it quits after a #BoycottNRA hashtag started to pick up steam online late Thursday.

The NRA was initially mum on the event but later went on offense during an annual gathering of conservatives at the Conservative Political Action Conference outside Washington Thursday, igniting the boycott.

The gun rights group's chief executive Wayne LaPierre openly criticized gun-control advocates and the media for its coverage of the shooting.

"They don't care about our schoolchildren," LaPierre said Thursday. "They want to make all of us less free," adding that Democrats are pushing a "socialist" agenda to deprive gun owners of their weapons.

Those comments, however, did not sit well with people who later took to Twitter urging companies to halt partnerships with the organization.

Here are the companies that have promptly responded to customers and severed their relationships with NRA.

Delta

The airline announced in a tweet on Saturday that:

"Delta is reaching out to the NRA to let them know we will be ending their contract for discounted rates through our group travel program. We will be requesting that the NRA remove our information from their website." 7:32 AM - Feb 24, 2018 Shortly after Delta announced that it would sever its partnership with the NRA, United Airlines tweeted that:

"United is notifying the NRA that we will no longer offer a discounted rate to their annual meeting and we are asking that the NRA remove our information from their website." 9:26 AM - Feb 24, 2018

First National Bank of Omaha

The Omaha bank was the first company to respond to the boycott. It tweeted that:

"Customer feedback has caused us to review our relationship with the NRA. As a result, First National Bank of Omaha will not renew its contract with the National Rifle Association to issue the NRA Visa Card." 1:25 PM - Feb 22, 2018

Enterprise Holdings

The rental car company followed a few hours later on Thursday, tweeting "all three of our brands have ended the discount for NRA members. This change will be effective March 26. Thank you again for reaching out."

National Car Rental

We ended the program – effective March 26. 6:29 PM - Feb 22, 2018

Symantec Corporation

On Friday, the software company announced in a tweet: "Symantec has stopped its discount program with the National Rifle Association." 10:24 AM - Feb 23, 2018

MetLife

The insurer also announced on Friday that it would break off from the NRA. It released a statement on Twitter saying: "We value all our customers but have decided to end our discount program with the NRA." 11:44 AM - Feb 23, 2018

United

U.S. Military Updates FBI's Background Check System With Over 4,000 Prohibited Former Service Members

In the months since ex-airman Devin Kelley opened fire in a Sutherland Springs, Texas church, the U.S. Military has reportedly added more than 4,000 names of dishonorably discharged military members to a national background check system.

You probably recall this horrific attack and the disturbing facts that arose afterwards, which revealed that the Air Force failed to submit Kelley's court records to the FBI's background check system; he had previously been in court for assaulting his wife and stepson back in 2012, and should have been banned from purchasing a firearm.

To fix this troubling issue, the Department of Defense has worked diligently to update the FBI's background check system. According to The Hill, this effort has weeded out 4,284 names that need to be updated in the FBI's background check system.

Blaming Gun Rights For FBI, Sheriff's Failures In Fla. Is Insane

The devastating revelation that sheriff's deputies stood outside while students were being murdered inside a Florida high school shows that the government failed massively, and efforts to blame gun rights for the tragedy are dishonest and insane.

Since the horror in Parkland the country has learned that the authorities had multiple warnings about the shooting suspect and repeatedly failed to act. The gun-free school zones law failed. And yet anti-gunners want to blame firearms and penalize law-

abiding gun owners.

For years, we have endured the efforts of anti-gun elitists and their political lap dogs to erode our rights and hold honest gun owners responsible for crimes they didn't commit.
